# HIGHLIGHTS

- Academics:** Atlee High School was named a recipient of the 2017 Board of Education Distinguished Achievement Award for advanced learning and achievement as part of the annual Virginia Index of Performance Awards. Designated as the first IB World School in Hanover County, Atlee had 30 students receive an IB diploma in 2017. State SOL scores include the following: Reading - 93%, Writing - 95%, Math - 90%, History - 92%, Science - 95%.
- Athletics:** In 2016-2017, Atlee High School captured nine team conference championships (Boys Volleyball, Competition Cheer, Girls Basketball, Boys Indoor Track, Boys Lacrosse, Girls Lacrosse, Girls Tennis, Softball, and Boys Outdoor Track), a regional championship (softball), and two state championships (archery and softball). The Raiders also captured twenty-two individual conference championships, seven individual regional championships, and two individual state championships.
- Extra-curricular activities:** In orchestra, two students were selected for the Senior Regional Orchestra, seven students were selected in the Central Regional Orchestra, and the program received an overall score of an Excellent Rating in Grade V music at the District Orchestra Assessment. In band, one student was selected as an All-State participant and the band program earned designation as a Virginia Honor Band for the 16th time. For the 2016-2017 school year, DECA had 23 students place in the top three at the district competition level with the following finishes: eight first place, 10 second place, five third place finishers, and 23 honorable mentions. At the DECA State Leadership Conference, Atlee had the following: four 1st place, one 2nd place, two 3rd place, and eight additional individual international qualifiers. Atlee's DECA advisor, Cindy Garrett, received the Outstanding Advisor Award and served as a competition director. Atlee DECA was also awarded the Gold Annual Report, DECA Day Participant, and Membership Campaign.
